

„Correct“ Waste Disposal Pays Off! IT IS IN YOUR HANDS

Non-Hazardous Hospital Waste

An improvement of the disposal discipline for non-hazardous hospital waste pays off as a result of the large waste amounts.

The amounts of non-hazardous hospital waste range between 160,000 kg (NZR), 630,000 kg (KAR) and 510,00 kg (KFJ).

Hazardous Hospital Waste

The saving potential for the hazardous hospital waste is high.

The disposal weight of the containers that is accounted for (8 kg) but also the maximal admissible one (9 kg/30 l resp. 18 kg/60 l) is by far not tapped. It ranges between 2.2 kg (NZR), 4.8 kg (KAR) and 5.8 kg (KFJ).

The maximal annual saving potential for non-hazardous hospital waste amounts to: in NZR € 27,000.-, in KFJ € 46,000.- and in KAR € 54,000.-.

The maximal annual saving potential for hazardous hospital waste amounts to: in NZR € 7,200.-, in KFJ € 20,000.- and in KAR € 37,000.-.
